A message from Mrs Tattersall....

Please can I remind parents again about school lunches needing to be paid IN ADVANCE.

The only time I would expect to see money owing for lunches is when you have paid a chunk of money in advance and it has run out. I am happy to give you a reminder at that point, but otherwise, there should be no meals that aren't paid for.

If you have received an email saying you owe money for school lunches, please pay it as soon as possible and ensure you pay IN ADVANCE in the future.

Pupil Attendance

As parents are most probably aware, there is a national drive for improved attendance in schools. To this end, the Truro & Penwith Academy Trust are monitoring our attendance. They have asked us to make sure we record the exact reason a child is off.



If we are recording a child with an attendance mark of 'ill', 'not feeling well' is no longer an acceptable comment, and we are expected to put a description of their illness.

There may also be occasions, if a child is persistently absent, that we ask for a doctor's note. Thank you for your understanding of our position and helping us to comply with this expectation.
