Fee-fi-fo-fum! The Christmas season is nearly here and we would like to give our school aged children (from Reception to Year 6) the chance to enjoy this year's pantomime at the Hall for Cornwall- Jack and the Beanstalk!

There will be a special performance for schools which will be lively and interactive. The trip will be near the end of term, on **Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> December**. We loved going to the panto as a school family last year and we are looking forward to our children enjoying their time together at the theatre again this year.

We will be leaving school after morning register and travelling by coach; the Pantomime starts at 11:00am so we will be back in plenty of time before the end of the school day.

Your child will need to wear their school uniform and bring a packed lunch and a water bottle. Our kitchen can provide a school packed lunch- please order this via Dojo message to Mrs Tattersall by **Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> December**.

Visiting the theatre to watch a live performance is a valuable and enriching experience; it encourages creativeness and inspires children to use their imagination. As I have mentioned before, we believe wholeheartedly in the value of these experiences. However, schools seldom have the financial resources to pay the full costs. **Our PTFA recognises the value in enabling our children to experience trips such as this one and have agreed to contribute significantly towards the tickets and the cost of the transport**, keeping the cost down for parents. We are asking for a contribution of **£10** per child, to go towards the cost of the pantomime and transport by coach (this is a much reduced cost thanks to the donation from the PTFA). Mrs Tattersall will set this up on Parent Pay.

The proceeds from this year's Christmas Fayre will be going towards this trip, so please do support us at the Fayre this Friday by coming along between 2:00 and 4:00. We are extremely grateful to our PTFA who work so hard for us volunteering, organising and supporting our school.

Everyone at Landewednack is automatically a member of the PTFA and we always welcome more volunteers, get in touch if you wish to help.

We are so grateful for your contributions which enable us, despite our distance from many activities and venues, to provide the children with fun, exciting and valuable days to remember.
