Medicine

We are currently updating our school policy on staff administering medicine to children during the school day. We are also seeking advice from County and reviewing the procedure as a MAT (Multi Academy Trust).

As with our current procedure staff can only administer medicine to children whose parents have given written instructions and completed the school medical form. However the medication must be clearly labelled and be in the original packaging either with the prescription or with advice written on the medication container dispensed by the pharmacist. We are not allowed to make the decision as to whether your child needs medication such as Calpol/ Paracetamol. Staff will contact parents immediately if they feel the children are poorly. Parents are welcome to come in to school to give their child medicine if they feel it necessary. Please inform your child's class teacher if you intend to do this.

Dinner Money

A reminder that the cost of a school dinner has now risen to £2.30. Please ensure that dinner money is placed in an envelope which is clearly marked with your child's name written on it. Mrs Tattersall has asked that dinner money payments be kept separate from any other payments and that it is paid by the end of each week. Please pay weekly, half termly or termly rather than daily as this can create an awful lot of loose change for Mrs Tattersall to count each week. The lunch menu hasn't changed from last term. We are due a new menu when we return to school after October half term.

A reminder that children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 can enjoy a school meal each day free of charge.




Jeans 4 Genes Day – Friday 21st September 2018
