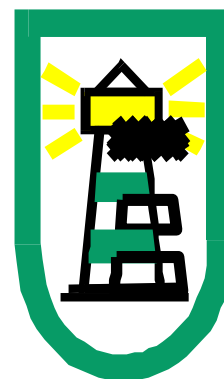

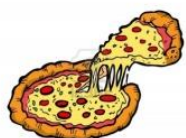

Seagulls - Well done to Elizabeth for working so hard on her letters and sounds.

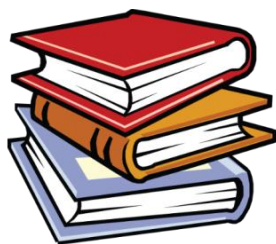
Choughs - Well done to Hector for being so kind and thoughtful in class and on the playground.
