Back Gate

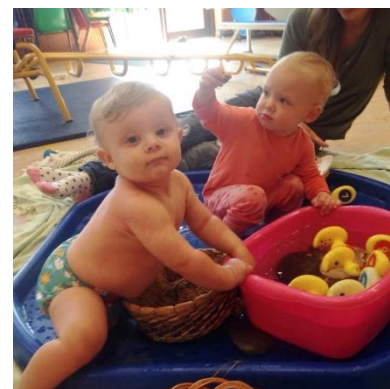
A reminder that the back gate from the playground into Croft Parc is locked from 9am each morning and not reopened until 3pm.
