Parents/carers, the PTFA are kindly asking for your help please.....

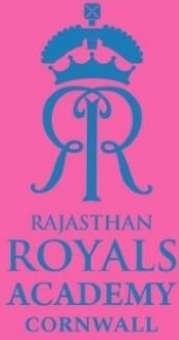
They will be serving delicious refreshments throughout the fayre and would very much appreciate any home baked or shop bought treats to be **brought in to school on the morning of the fayre.**

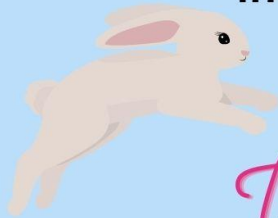
