We will be acknowledging **Red Nose Day** again on Friday 21st March in aid of the Comic Relief charity.

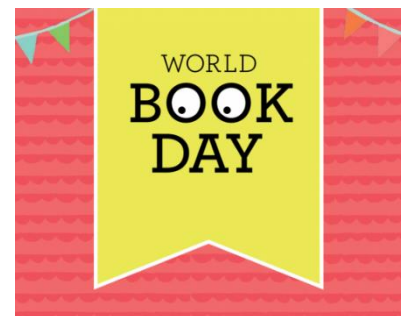

Choughs class even made their own St Piran's flags using Cornish themed pictures drawn by the children and put together by Rhian and Bella - fantastic!





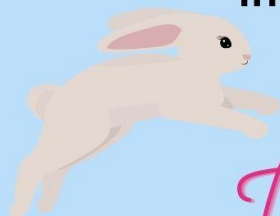
